E. Judgment rule

What “good enough to keep” meant tonight

Why a fluent reply is not placement or speed proof

If all three discarded as unsuitable, workload layer not practically usable

Yes / Not applicable

F. Assian one verdict

Allowed verdicts are exactly Ready for Chapter 14, Blocked, or Evidence missing.

Finite verdict

Binding reason

Next proof

Invalidation condition

Ready for Chapter 14 is not an audition and not a privacy lesson. It means three bounded tasks were run and judged. If all three are discard because the artifact is unsuitable, record that the workload layer is not practically usable.

Deterministic self-check
